DEVELOPMENT OF DOUBLE BASS IN ESA REGION
<p>Italy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">A new Double Bass Teacher Trainer course began in Italy in November, involving eight teachers across multiple levels: four in Level 1, one in Level 2 and three in Level 3. The participants are from Denmark, Estonia, Latvia and Italy. There was also strong interest from Spain, France and the Netherlands, and it is anticipated that teachers from these countries will join future courses.
