<p>We (the Recorder Teacher Trainers) held a successful worldwide online conference in March 2023 and will be repeating it in March 2024.</p> <p>As mentioned in last year's report, we commissioned Heleen Verleur to compose some original ensemble arrangements for all the pieces in Soprano Book 1. These have now been successfully tried out at last year's Flute &amp; Recorder Summer School. Due to copyright issues, she is unable to publish them herself.</p>
<b>ITEMS FROM ISA RECORDER COMMITTEE</b>
<p>Jaap Delver is finalising the revisions to Book 1 and we hope to circulate it this year.</p> <p>The five Recorder Teacher Trainers continue to meet regularly every 2 to 3 months to discuss ongoing Suzuki Recorder matters.</p>
<b>DEVELOPMENT OF RECORDER IN ESA REGION</b>
<p>There is no Level 1 TT Course running for the BSMA this year. Last year's trainees are continuing with Level 2.</p> <p>I have started an Independent TT Course for Levels 2, 3, 4 &amp; 5. This will stretch over 2 years - 50% is online and the rest is face to face meeting in Iceland where Suzuki Recorder has really taken off! (6 trainees are from Iceland, 1 from Poland, 1 Czechia, 1 Switzerland and 1 England).</p> <p>Jaap Delver is continuing to run a Level 1 TT Course in Holland.</p>
