

Teacher Training Courses for Cello Suzuki

(Levels 1, 2, 3 y 4)

Summary of the rules published in the FEMS website

CHARACTERISTICS

The course corresponds to **levels 1, 2, 3 and 4** of the **Suzuki Cello** teacher training. The teacher in charge of the course is **Eulàlia Subirà, ESA Teacher Trainer**.

The course is **structured in meetings (face-to-face and online)**, periodical 2-3 days long, mainly on weekends, the Suzuki Pedagogical Days and the Suzuki National Course. Occasionally, the meetings will coincide with other Suzuki teacher training courses at different levels and specialities. There will be common sessions on Suzuki philosophy and general topics given by the teacher trainers of the different courses and instruments. Occasionally, guest teachers may be invited. It will be taught in Spanish, but knowledge of spoken and written English is required. Several meetings will be attended by: **Tessa Oakley, Carey Beth Hockett, Chantal Latil, Anja Maja and Regina Fuentes**, national and international Suzuki teacher trainers, as a complement and enrichment.



ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

Registration exclusively online.

Admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis for those registrations that meet the requirements and the course management's approval of access.

To Access level 1:

- Official Professional Degree or proof of an equivalent musical level. Video audition:
- **Video audition:**
 - First or Third movement of the **Sonata in G M by G.B. Sammartini** (Suzuki vol.8)
 - **"Élégie" op.24** by G.Fauré or **"Allegro Appassionato" op. 43** by C. **Saint-Saëns** (Suzuki vol. 8)
 - Oral presentation explaining motivations.

To access the rest of the levels:

- Certificate/diploma awarded by the ESA of the previous level.
- To be up to date with the Spanish Federation.

DATES

Registration deadline:

- **Level 1 -> 10th January.**
- **Other levels 25 January 2023**

Registration exclusively online, payment of €50 is required as confirmation.

Approximate duration between 110 and 120 hours.

Exams: to be determined (October/November 2023).

EXAM

The examination board of the European Suzuki Association consists of three teacher trainers from different countries

Requirements:

Attendance at least 90% of the training hours. To be up to date with payment. Recommendation of the teacher trainer. Be up to date with: Required readings; Observation of classes; Personal study of the instrument and submission of written assignments.

PRICE

Includes: TT Training Meetings, Pedagogical Conferences, National Course and Examination Fees.

Does not include: Meals, accommodation and travel.

Payment must be made by bank transfer. Consult discounts for former students.

Level 1: 50€ registration activation fee + 1.625€ enrolment fee + 300€ exam fees = **1.975€**.

Levels 2, 3 or 4: 50€ enrolment activation + 1.500€ registration fee + 300€ exam fees = **1.850€**.

DISCOUNTS AND BONUSES

- **190€** discount for payment in one instalment before 20 January.
- Former students of training courses organised by the FEMS: an additional **75€** discount.

Payment in 5 bimonthly instalments is authorised.
