ESA Suzuki Voice Teacher training

Teacher Training (Level 1 - 5)

Each European Suzuki Voice training level consists of 100-120 hours depending on the level and each level is expected to be completed in one to two years. After an initial training period, the teacher-in-training will teach students under supervision.

Suzuki Voice teachers are examined on the following: Public Recital, Teaching (group and individual lessons), Conversation / Oral examination (Suzuki Philosophy, Suzuki Voice Program, Vocal pedagogy) and Playing skills.

Acceptance to the Suzuki Voice Teacher Training

To be accepted as a teacher-in-training, an audition recording (an internet link) and CV in English should be submitted for acceptance. A panel of ESA teacher trainers will evaluate the audition.

Your CV should include Bachelor of Music degree (or equivalent) in classical voice studies, professional performance experience and teaching experience. Also include any experience with the Suzuki Method or working with young children.

Please take care of the quality of your audition recording and its sound/image.
