1. The International Suzuki Association ("ISA"), a not for profit corporation of Texas, whose address is 300 Green Bay Road, Winnetka, IL 60093 has been designated by Dr. Shinichi Suzuki and Waltraud Suzuki (hereinafter jointly referred to as "Suzuki") as the organization which is to carry on Dr. Suzuki's philosophy, standards, and goals for the education of children and parents using his "Suzuki Method"™ instructional techniques and program. Suzuki has accordingly formally transferred to the ISA the exclusive ownership and use rights in Dr. Suzuki's name, Rights of Publicity, and the marks "Suzuki", "Suzuki Method" and other terms in every country of the world in connection with goods, products and services, and particularly in connection with these activities whose purpose is to unite people professionally engaged or otherwise interested in teaching under the philosophy and methodology developed by Dr. Suzuki for the purpose of offering educational instruction in music, math, language, physics and other
